

Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics:

The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 13,790 and changed to 20,053 in 2000, representing a change of 45.4%. The household count in 2005 was 24,096 and the household projection for 2010 is 27,214, a change of 12.9%.


The population in the study area in 1990 was **41,563** and in 2000 it was **59,972**, roughly a **44.3%** change. The population in 2005 was **74,357** and the projection for 2010 is **86,481** representing a change of **16.3%**.


Population by Age



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **31.2**, and in 2000, it was **33.1**. The median age in 2005 is **34.2** and it is predicted to change in five years to **35.4** years. In 2005, females represented **48.7%** of the population with a median age of **34.9** and males represented **51.3%** of the population with a median age of **33.6** years. In 2005, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **75 +** years.






In 2005 the predominant household income category in this study area is \$75K - \$100K, and the income group that is least represented in this geography is \$15K - \$25K.


